### How will my courses transfer to UA Little Rock?

When evaluating what transfers, not all of your courses will have a direct course equivalent at UA Little Rock; however, they may be applied to UA Little Rock core requirements.

For example, PSC 114 Physical Science has no direct equivalency but will satisfy four hours of science core.
