#### For students interested in a Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA)

Admission of declared art majors to the Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) in Art, which includes tracks in Fine Art (or Studio Art) and Applied Design, occurs via a review process that includes: required coursework (classes taken at UA-PTC are highlighted in the degree plan), portfolio review, application, typed statement of the student's goals, BOSS transcript review and a brief interview. Note that the review for admission to the BFA is a two-step process requiring submission of the BOSS transcript statement, and application initially and the submission of the portfolio and the interview two weeks later. Students will be informed in writing of the outcome of the admission process. Letters will arrive within one month of the portfolio review. Students are allowed a total of three attempts to pass the review before they are ineligible for the BFA program. Students who have not gained admission to the BFA program may be graduated with a BA degree.
