All students take BSAD 2010, Introduction to Career Catalyst upon declaring a major in the School. Over the period of their School of Business coursework, students must complete at least one activity in each of five career development areas. In the semester a student applies for graduation, he or she also registers for BSAD 4010, Career Catalyst Completion to have their activities certified.

<sup>7</sup> The UA Little Rock business core requires students to demonstrate proficiency with use of information technology through testing.

<sup>8</sup> For completing your degree and ease of transfer, UA Little Rock prefers BUS 1013, Introduction to Business for your elective.
