Elementary and Intermediate Spanish

SPAN 1311 Elementary Spanish I (in person OR online)

A course for students with no knowledge of Spanish. Instruction in correct pronunciation, aural comprehension, and simple speaking ability.

SPAN 1312 Elementary Spanish II (in person OR online)

Prerequisite: SPAN 1311 or equivalent. Practice in correct pronunciation, aural comprehension, and simple speaking ability leading to mastery of basic grammar and limited reading ability.

SPAN 2311 Intermediate Spanish (in person OR online)

Prerequisite: SPAN 1312 or equivalent. The intermediate course leads to a greater facility in the spoken language and to more advanced reading skills. Prerequisites: [SPAN 1312](#) or equivalent.

Advanced Skills

SPAN 3303 Spanish for Heritage Speakers (in-person/synchronous OR online)

This class offers an intensive study of Spanish language and cultural issues unique to heritage speakers that will improve their academic and professional speaking and writing. Prerequisite: WEB CAPE score of 427 or above OR consent of the instructor.

SPAN 3314 Spanish for Writing (online)

Practice reading authentic text and writing in a variety of context. Leads to greater control of specific grammatical and syntactic structures, expanded vocabulary, ability to self-edit, and advanced-low proficiency. Three credit hours. Prerequisites: [SPAN 2311](#) or equivalent.

SPAN 3315 Translation Studies (online)

Students refine their language skills and learn to express themselves more accurately in Spanish by focusing on form through intensive translation practice. Includes practice in both Spanish-to-English and English-to-Spanish translations. Three credit hours. Prerequisite: SPAN 2312 or equivalent.

SPAN 3335 Culture: Americas (online)

Historical, sociological, and cultural background of Latin America. Prerequisite: [SPAN 2311](#) or equivalent.

SPAN 4310 Structured Internship (hybrid)

A course that allows students to use Spanish in a professional setting in the central Arkansas community. Students are required to perform 90 (ninety) hours of service as an intern at an external site. Prerequisites: [SPAN 3313](#), [SPAN 3314](#), [SPAN 3316](#), [SPAN 3317](#) OR consent of the instructor.

SPAN 4361 Seminar: Afro-Latino Literatures and Cultures (online)

This course offers a survey of the literary and cultural production of Afro-Latinos. Prerequisites: [SPAN 3313](#), [SPAN 3314](#), [SPAN 3316](#), [SPAN 3317](#) OR consent of the instructor.
